Wells RFC – FIFA World Cup 2010 Competition

Its nearly time for the big kick off and a chance for you to have a bit of fun, show everybody what an authority you are on football, and perhaps win some money.

Prize money will be announced when all entries have been received.

Invite your friends to enter too. The more who enter, the more money you can win.

To make it easier for you, I have made available an electronic score sheet (World Cup.xls) which you can fill in with your forecasts. The group tables will be calculated for you and the knock out stage will be updated automatically. The draw for the knock out stages is based on the FIFA Website.

The rules for this competition are as follows:

Place a number against each team on the entry sheet (wcupentry.doc), indicating how many goals you think they will score throughout the whole competition.

Penalty points will be calculated by adding the differences between the actual goals scored and your forecast for each team. The person with the fewest penalty points will be the winner

In the event of a tie, the person with most correct forecasts will be the winner.

If a game goes to extra time, the goals scored in the extra half hour will count. However any goals scored in a penalty shoot out will be ignored

Only the 64 games referred to on information sheet (world cup fixtures.doc) will count. Any unscheduled additional games will be ignored.

If any games are abandoned, the score from the replayed game will count. If it is not replayed, the score as it was will count.

In the event of any disputes, the judge's decisions on any rulings will be final.
